#### 1. FY22-23 Proposed Budget



### FY22-23 Budget Recommendations

- Maintain Basin Production Percentage at 77%
- Increase Replenishment Assessment from \$507/af to \$544/af
  - Generate PFAS funding
  - GWRS Final Expansion comes online
- No MWD untreated water purchases
- Accumulated Overdraft remains the same with average hydrology next winter
- Draft recommended budget to Board on March 2, 2022
- Final Board consideration on April 20, 2022

## Perfluorooctanic Acid (PFOA)

- 10 ppt PFOA Response Level has been established by State DDW
- 59 wells currently need treatment expect more
- \$277 million current capital cost
- Have obtained \$95 million low interest EPA WIFIA Loan
- OCWD seeking outside grant funding
- Litigation against manufacturers has been initiated

#### **PFAS Treatment Plants**



- Board adopted a policy to fund 100% design and construction & 50% of ongoing O&M costs
- 11 impacted cities and water districts
- Treatment systems are being built in Orange County over the next 2 years
- 14 wells are already online



City of Fullerton First operating plant June 2021





Yorba Linda Water District Largest in nation December 2021

# Potential SOC/MNWD Emergency Water Supply Program

- Existing SOC Emergency Water Supply Agreement could expire in 2033 – Requires three-year notice (2030)
- New potential program would be similar but use city of Santa Ana water system vs IRWD to send water south
- Board approved agreement in January 2019 to consider program with MNWD
- Currently negotiating an agreement with city of Santa Ana and MNWD to provide preliminary design of needed facilities and CEQA – MNWD paying for work
- Board approved policy in July 2021 on the terms to provide water to SOC agencies
